SPRING BLENDED/ON-LINE COURSE INFORMATION LETTER**

You are scheduled for GEDU 601 blended/on-line course this spring. *Students are required to attend a pre-course class and a post course meeting if they wish to take this course.* A significant amount of procedural protocols need to be reviewed prior to beginning your research project. For this reason, you should expect the first class meeting to be similar to the traditional classes of the cohort. Please note the start time on the chart below

PRE COURSE CLASS MEETING – At the pre-course class, students will receive a syllabus, overview of the course content, learning outcomes, assessments and on-line contact protocols. Students will also review all of the necessary research protocols and portfolio standards to begin their project. The pre-course class will not go beyond 5pm.

POST COURSE MEETING – Students will complete presentations and evaluations as required by the professor. The presentations may be scheduled in small groups so students will only be required to attend during the group presentations. Professors will inform you of the procedures.
