Scholarship Celebration set

A long-time college president and a civic club dedicated to furthering students' education will be honored by Gannon University Saturday for their service to Catholic Higher Education.

William P. Garvey, Ph.D., and the Erie Wolves Club Den VIII will be honored Oct. 20 at Gannon's 14th annual Scholarship Celebration. The honorees will be presented with the university's Archbishop Gannon Medal of Distinction, presented each year at the black-tie fundraiser to individuals who have been instrumental in promoting the cause of Catholic higher education.

Erie Bishop Donald W. Trautman, chair of Gannon's Board of Trustees, said the two award recipients have served as superb role models for Gannon's students, helping them to understand the values of selfless service to humanity.

Gannon will honor Garvey, an alumnus of Gannon, for his decades of service to Erie higher education, most notably his past 21 years as president of Mercyhurst College.

Garvey earned his bachelor of arts degree from Gannon College, now Gannon University, in 1957, his master of arts degree in history from the University of Pittsburgh in 1959, and his doctoral degree in history in 1973, also from the University of Pittsburgh.

After teaching in Pittsburgh, Garvey came to Mercyhurst in 1962, serving in numerous academic roles before assuming his current post as president in 1980. As president, Garvey continues to teach a class or two each year.

Under Garvey's leadership, the college completed a \$25 million program of new buildings and campus renovations and opened the college's branch campus in North East. Now in its 75th anniversary year, the college currently is running a \$20 million campaign under Garvey's leadership.

The evening's second honoree, the Erie Wolves Club, is part of the National Association of the Wolves that exists to provide four-year college scholarships to deserving students. The first Wolves Club was founded in 1929 in New Castle, and the National Association of Wolves was organized in 1951 and

The Erie Den awards scholarships at high schools in Erie County and makes selections based on scholastic standing and degree of financial need. The committee is aided in its selection process by the Gannon University Office of Financial Aid and various high school guidance counselors.

The Oct. 20 event, held in Gannon's Waldron Campus Center, will begin with a reception at 6 p.m. followed by the awards dinner at 7 p.m. An after-dinner reception will feature entertainment by singer Mary Alice Brown.
