LOCATING A BOOK

Catalog

The library's online catalog provides a means for searching for books available in the library's collection. Students are able to determine which specific books are available or unavailable for checkout. Books can be searched by author, series, subject, and title. The easiest way to determine if the library has access to journals is to search for the journal by selecting *Title Alphabetical Search* from the drop down box on the library catalog search page. Interlibrary Loan (ILLiad)

Interlibrary loan is a service that allows students to access materials from other libraries which are not owned by the Nash Library. Students must register by clicking on the following link. Students must create an account with a user name and password. Be sure to have student ID on hand as it requests the ID number on the bottom left of the ID card. Requests are usually processed within 24 hours, but may take 10 business days to receive. A benefit of ILLiad is that a request can be made to have articles sent electronically through E-mail which decreases waiting time. Books can be borrowed for up to two weeks and must be picked up at the Service Desk. Be sure to give descriptive information, as it will speed up retrieval process. LOCATING AN ARTICLE

Databases

The library subscribes to database services that hold many full text psychological and counseling journals: EBSCOhost and PsycArticles. All of these databases hold American Psychological Association and non-APA psychology journals, as well as American Counseling Association and non-ACA counseling journals. The journals held in each of these databases are identified in this guide and can be accessed by following the link below.

EBSCOhost database has full text access to over 9000 titles. The collection includes mainly online access that accompanies a print subscription. This database provides users with the ability to search many print titles by keyword, author, or title.

- **Academic Search Premier** is the world's largest academic multi-disciplinary database. Academic Search premier provides full text articles for more than 4,500 publications, including full text for more than 3,600 peer-reviewed journals. The following journals are available in full text format.

- **ERIC**, the Educational Resource Information Center contains more than 2,200 digests along with references for additional information, citations, and abstracts from over 980 educational and education-related journals. It contains information pertinent to school counseling, school psychology, and child/adolescent development. ERIC combines citations from the following sources:
 - Education and education-related journals, designated in the database with the prefix EJ and a six-digit code (example: EJ123456)
 - Non-journal materials from school districts, government entities, and educational associations, etc. Documents may include: reports, lesson plans, guides, tests, statistics, and other materials. These resources are classified with the prefix ED and a six-digit code (example ED123456)
- **Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition** provides more than 550 scholarly full text journals focusing on many medical disciplines.

FirstSearch is a collection of databases that provide access to journals published from 1995 to the present that encompasses a large variety of subject areas using keyword searching. Full-text access is not available through FirstSearch, though citations to thousands of articles are provided. Twelve databases are accessed through FirstSearch; two of the most relevant are listed below:

- **Medline** database provides keyword, author, and title searching for over 15,000,000 records from 9,584 sources in all areas of medicine including psychiatry. This database is updated daily.
- **Worldcat** provides Gannon students with access to library collections worldwide. This database can be used to locate monographs needed by students that are not found in the Nash Library collection. Books can be borrowed by using the InterLibrary Loan (ILL) program. This database is updated daily.

APA PsychArticles database provides keyword, author, and title searching for over 2,100,000 records; and includes 1,760 sources in many areas of psychology from the early 1800s to the present. This database is sponsored by APA and is updated weekly.

- **APA PsychArticles** is a database of full text journals which encompasses both PsycARTICLES and PsycINFO. Article publication years range from 1917 to the present and utilize keyword, title, author, etc. for searching purposes.
- PsychArticles is designed specifically for APA databases and combines unequalled knowledge of psychology and behavioral science with the latest search technology. It harnesses the power of APA indexing, providing focused research with multidisciplinary impact.

JSTOR is a high-quality, interdisciplinary archive that includes select monographs and over 1,000 journals that consists of information from the humanities and social sciences. All journals begin with volume 1, issue 1, although issues from the past 3-5 years are not available electronically.

- *JSTOR* is a database of full text journals which can be accessed from the *JSTOR* link on the *Article Indices* segment of the library webpage.

- The database allows users to browse by discipline, title, and publisher. *JSTOR* provides a list of upcoming journals that are in the process of being acquired and digitized in preparation for release.

Counseling and Psychotherapy Transcripts, Client Narratives, and Reference Works is a landmark database that contains more than 2,000 transcripts of actual therapy sessions. It has 40,000 pages of client narratives, and 25,000 pages of major reference works.

- Database includes diaries, letters, autobiographies, oral histories, and personal memoirs along with full text of therapy and counseling sessions.
- All accounts are non-fiction and delivered in first person.
- Database is updated bi-weekly.

OTHER ONLINE RESOURCES

Google Scholar

Google has expanded its influence. It now provides a search engine to find scholarly literature. Go to the Google homepage and click on *more* at the top of the screen. Select *Scholar*. From here, it would be best to utilize *Advanced Search* options to select

appropriate criteria including *English* as the preferred language. This will significantly narrow the search and ease the selection process.

Helpful Hint: *Students are able to preset preferences in order to narrow searches. Be sure to access this through the GU Portal.*
